This question can be addressed in many ways, including but not limited to, the kind of questions sociologists should be asking at this time; the issues important for sociological analysis; the social, cultural, economic, or political consequences; the major sociological issues to arise within your national context and/or across national boundaries. We welcome commentaries from researchers across the globe, with a focus on a single society, a set of countries, regions, continents, or global.

The deadline to submit a commentary is June 30th, 2020, and should be submitted via our site (https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/acta_soc) along with a short bio (max 100 words). Due to the urgent need to understand the sociological implications of COVID-19, all the commentaries accepted for publication by the editors will be published online immediately.
