

### Structure + Checklist

- ❑ **Introduction** [ motivation for undertaking the research, outcome – focus on relevance of the phenomenon being studied, the context it is being studied in and how it is contributing to the literature]
- ❑ **Theoretical Anchoring**
  - Broad Theoretical Inspiration/Theoretical Anchoring [elaborating on the theoretical anchor and identifying limitation in its current form]
  - Research Question [ ‘how’ and/or ‘why’]
- ❑ **Methodology**
  - Why Case Method in addressing the Research Question [ key: deeper/ granular understanding needed, provide justification of using qualitative case method]
  - Why ‘that’ case [ key: ‘fit’ to theoretical sampling, unusual access, richness of data, also discuss about the context] – interesting, novel, relevant
  - Access and Engagement: entering and exiting field
  - Data Collection Techniques [Data table]
- ❑ **Findings**
  - Narratives and Theorization [ Data analysis and presentation]
  - Story presented in a logical but engaging way [ Event/ milestone diagram ]
  - Data Structure [ Table] [ Proof Quote/ illustrative example Table]
  - Emergent Theoretical Model [ Diagram]
- ❑ **Discussion**
  - Contribution [what is new that wasn’t before- connect with previous literature - conversions/diversions]
  - Implication [how the ‘new’ elements alter/ extend/ modify/ challenge extant theoretical understandings]
  - Limitation [what factors limit the generalisability of the new theoretical model]
- ❑ **Conclusion**
  - Summarise study
  - Future Research
- ❑ **Reference**
  - Latest APA style
