



Environmental Health Insights: **Call for Editor-in-Chief**

SAGE announces the search for a new Editor-in-Chief (EiC) for our journal, *Environmental Health Insights* (Impact Factor: 2.3). We are currently accepting applications for an initial term of 3 years, commencing immediately.

Environmental Health Insights is an international, peer-reviewed, open-access online journal focusing on how environmental factors affect the health of individuals and societies. This includes air quality (ambient and indoor), water quality and

The Editor in Chief will be responsible for:

The editorial content of the journal

- Uphold a high standard of publication ethics in the journal, which includes ensuring that the journal states and adheres to a rigorous peer review policy.
- Manage selection and revision of articles through peer review in accordance with SAGE policies, processes, and operational aspects, including the articles' technical content, form, conciseness, clarity, and accuracy.
- Make final decisions on all published content.
- Ensure all published content is in scope and high quality.
- Manage deadlines and ensure the delivery of adequate copy.
- Maintain regular communication with the publisher.

Article solicitation

- Seek out potential authors and invite content to the journal.
- Utilize professional and academic networks to identify potential authors.
- Meet minimum requirements of invited content per year.

Journal development

- Lead the strategic development of the journal, including growing published content.
- Develop and engage with the editorial board, including hosting conference calls.
- Suggest and solicit topics for special collections.
- Identify opportunities for sponsorship or partnership with relevant societies, organizations, or institutes.
- Implement strategies for increasing the number of high-quality submissions, usage, citations, and other measures of success for the journal.

Act as an advocate for the journal

- Represent and promote the journal at conferences, as appropriate.
- Highlight the journal within professional and academic networks and forums.
- Promote the journal when possible; utilize social media when appropriate.

The ideal candidate will:

- Have demonstrable experience and broad knowledge of the field of environmental health research.
- Have strong experience in writing for, reviewing for and/or working on a journal in the capacity of Editor or Editorial Board member.
- Have a good understanding of the peer review process, as well as peer review and publication ethics.
- Be familiar with the use of online submission systems.
- Have a strong academic research background in a recognised university or equivalent institution.
- Be organized, responsive, proactive and driven.
- Have good knowledge of the English language, although not necessarily native English speaking.

Applicants should send a letter of application which includes their vision for the future of the journal and a description of their qualifications for the editorship. Applicants should also include copies of their CV.
