

## Call for Papers

World geo-political landscape has never been more dynamic, environmental pressures- more severe, and emerging threats to globalization more challenging. Year 2020 seems as a good time to revisit inquiries into the role of globalization and world connectivity for economic development and human prosperity. What does a post-COVID-19 world look like in terms of trade and investment flows? What is the future of economic connectivity and what are policies that would lead to the desirable outcomes? How do we put in perspective the range of challenges we are facing: disruptions and uncertainty in global trade and investment flows; environmental implications of international economic activity; and accelerating automation, falling labor shares, and increasing income inequality in the context of an interconnected world.

### Tentative list of topics for the Special Issue:

- Scenarios and policies for post-COVID-19 recovery of trade and investment.
- Global value chains in times of uncertainty.
- Environmental risks and impacts of trade and FDI.
- Trade, FDI and ecological footprints.
- Emerging industries and structural change- the role of trade and FDI
- Innovation and de-industrialization- the role of trade and FDI.
- Automation and income inequality- the impact of trade and FDI.
- Trade and FDI in knowledge-specific assets.
- Dynamic comparative advantage and the emergence of FDI from developing countries.

### Content

The lists of themes are meant to define the broader context of the special issue. We welcome a diversity of research on the topic. Studies at country-, industry- and firm-level are welcome. The manuscript length requirements are flexible, but to a maximum of 10,000 words.
