

## ***Literature & History* – Proposing a Special Issue**

The editors of *Literature & History* welcome proposals for special issues, which will generally comprise a brief introduction and 5-6 original articles. Proposals may concern any historical period(s) and should consist of the following:

- A statement (500-1000 words) explaining the proposed issue's rationale, originality and theoretical underpinnings. The statement should make clear how contributions to the issue will, together and/or individually, engage with the relationship between literature and history.
- Abstracts (300-500 words each) for the essays. Completed articles will normally be between 6000 and 8000 words in length, including references.
- Short biographical notes for each editor and contributor to the proposed issue.
- An estimated timeline for preparation and submission of the full manuscript.

The above should be sent as a single document (Word or PDF) to the journal editors.
