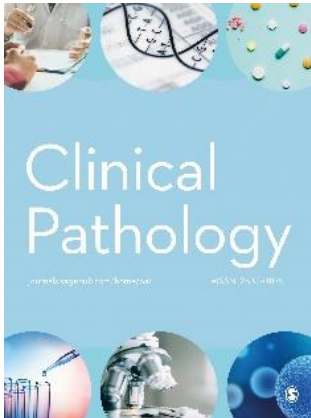


Call for Applications: New Editor-in-Chief for *Clinical Pathology*

SAGE announces the search for a new **Editor-in-Chief (EiC)** of our journal, [Clinical Pathology](#). We are currently accepting applications for an initial term of 3 years.

Journal Description:



Clinical Pathology (PAT), is an international, peer-reviewed, open access journal that focuses on all aspects of clinical pathology, including pathogenesis, diagnostics, the genetic basis of pathology, translational research, infection control, and medical microbiology.

The Journal is indexed in PubMed Central (PMC), Scopus, ESCI, ProQuest, EBSCO, and the DOAJ, and will be receiving its first Impact Factor this year.

Editor-in-Chief Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the editorial content of the journal
 - Uphold a high standard of publication ethics in the journal, which includes ensuring that the journal states and adheres to a rigorous peer review policy
 - Manage selection and revision of articles through peer review in accordance with SAGE policies, processes, and operational aspects, including the articles' technical content, form, conciseness, clarity, and accuracy
 - Make final decisions on all published content
 - Ensure all published content is in scope and high quality
 - Manage deadlines and ensuring the delivery of adequate copy
 - Maintain regular communication with the publisher
- Article solicitation
 - Seek out potential authors and invite content to the journal
 - Utilize professional and academic networks to identify potential authors
 - Meet minimum requirements of invited content per year
- Journal development
 - Develop and engage with the editorial board, including hosting conference calls
 - Suggest and solicit topics for special collections
 - Identify opportunities for sponsorship or partnership with relevant societies, organizations, or institutes

- Act as an advocate for the journal
 - Represent and promote the journal at conferences, as appropriate
 - Highlight the journal within professional and academic networks and forums
 - Promoting the Journal when possible; utilize social media when appropriate

General Qualifications

- The applicant must have good knowledge of the English language, although not necessarily native English speaking
- Doctoral degree, preferably research doctorate (PhD)
- Substantive experience as guest editor, associate editor, or senior editorial board member
- Published in the specialty or discipline
- Currently engaged in research or practice in the discipline
- Broad knowledge of the field
- Strong leadership and communication skills
- Organizational and time management skills

Additional Information

- SAGE Publishing will provide training in editorial processes and the online submission/peer review system, and will offer advice, support and assistance as required
- The EiC is entitled to a yearly stipend as agreed upon with SAGE publisher
- The contract period is three years, with renewal options
