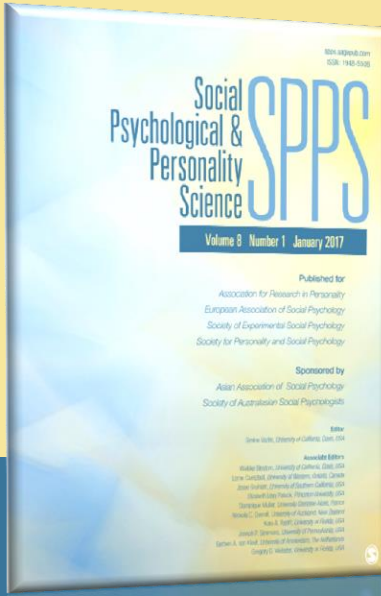

**Special Issue: The Social/Personality Psychology
of Recent Geopolitical Events**

SPPS invites submissions for a special section featuring social psychological and/or personality research on recent geopolitical events. This research could focus on broad themes (e.g., the rise of nationalism, the rise of distrust towards elites including scientists, changing attitudes towards immigration, etc.) or specific events (e.g., Brexit, the Syrian refugee crisis, the attempted coup in Turkey, Trump's election in the US, Duterte's election and presidency in the Philippines, etc.). The research should have a strong connection to social and/or personality psychology.

Articles cannot exceed 5,000 words (excluding tables, figures, and references), and preference will be given to articles that are methodologically rigorous and have theoretical and practical significance.
