Book Review Guidelines

1. Book Reviews should normally run to between 1,200 and 1,400 words, which gives scope for an assessment of the book and its contribution to knowledge and discussion within the broad field of urban studies.

2. Reviews should be typed in double spacing.

3. Book Review headings should include the title, author, year of publication, publisher, number of pages, price and ISBN number, as in the following example:

Environmental Rights: Critical perspectives

Christopher Miller

2005

London: Routledge

Xxx pp.

£50.00 hardback

ISBN: xxx x xxxxx xxx x hardback

4. Page numbers for quotations should be provided along with any references.

5. The Reviewer's name, department and affiliation should be included at the end of the review.

6. The Book Review should be submitted to the Urban Studies Manuscript Central database at <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/cus> using the instructions given in the original e-mail. 7. The review should be submitted approximately three months from receipt of the book.

8. No payment is made for reviews but the contributor is allowed to retain the book.
